

Gateway

Gateway is a workplace exploration initiative for senior students (years 11 -13). This program is designed to help students gain an in-depth knowledge of their career path while gaining industry related NCEA credits.

This ensures that a student has a thorough understanding of their specific vocation when they transition from school to further education or employment.

What is Gateway?

Gateway is a twelve-month program that provides structured workplace learning.

Selected senior students gain new skills and knowledge in a specific employment environment while studying industry-related credits towards NCEA qualifications.

The Tertiary Education Commission fully funds Gateway and all work placement equipment, clothing and footwear is provided.

How it works:

- Students need to be matched with potential employers and may need to attend an interview at their prospective work place
- Once their work placement is confirmed a student will receive a minimum of ten placement days with an employer
- An individual learning plan is created for every student to ensure they are fully supported in achieving their goals
- Industry-related credits are gained through completing courses, attending workshops as well as working through selected unit standards from industry training organizations
