Rules for all students

Jewellery

Students must not wear jewellery, except for:

- A watch
- One taonga as a cultural item, which should be worn at such a length that it is below the open button at the top of the shirt
- One plain stud earring or small sleeper earring per ear.
- One plain nose stud is permitted. No other facial piercings are permitted. Sticking plaster over piercings or retainers are permitted.
- Tongue studs are not permitted

Hair and Makeup

- Reasonable make up may be worn
- Hair is to be of one natural colour
- No extreme hair styles
- Students at all levels must be clean shaven

Year 9 and Year 10 - Regulation Uniform

Boys

- School Regulation Dark navy trousers or shorts
- Green shirt, short or long sleeves with the Mountainview monogram and tailored bottom
- Mountainview High School tie
- Mountainview High School blazer
- Mountainview High School socks – long with red and navy stripe to be worn with the shorts
- Black socks or long school socks to be worn with the trousers
- Black leather lace-up shoe – traditional school shoe
- MVHS PE Shorts and Whanau tee-shirt

Boys Optional

- Mountainview High School Knit jersey – green jersey with red and navy neck stripe
- Mountainview High School Regulation Jacket
- MVHS Scarf

Year 9 and Year 10 - Regulation Uniform

Girls

- School Regulation Dark navy skirt
- Green blouse, short or long sleeves with the Mountainview monogram and tailored bottom
- Mountainview High School tie
- Mountainview High School blazer
- Black knee highs above the knee or black ankle socks which must show above the shoe
- Black leather shoe, either lace-up or buckled
- MVHS PE Shorts and Whanau tee-shirt

Girls Optional

- School Regulation Tailored navy shorts
- Mountainview knit jersey or cardigan – green jersey with red and navy neck stripe
- Mountainview High School Regulation Jacket
- MVHS Scarf

Formal Occasions

The blazer and tie must be worn to school assemblies and at any time students are representing the school in the community. Both may be worn at any time as part of the everyday uniform, which many students choose to do.

Year 11, Year 12 and Year 13

Regulation uniform is as per the junior uniform with the following exceptions.

- Green shirts are replaced with white shirts for both boys and girls. The white shirts may be, short or long-sleeved, with the Mountainview monogram and tailored bottom.
- In year 13, the tie is replaced with a thick red striped tie.
